1. Maintenance of our Bonnet Shores Nature Trail - 6 Volunteers needed from March to October:

- Prune trail so there is easy access through the path
- Remove any invasive vines on plants/trees
- Rake and Bag leaves and debris (supply brown paper bags)
- May need chainsaw for fallen tree limbs
- American flags to be placed at the beginning and end of the trail (Neal Colman has graciously offered to donate these flags)
- Time commitment is no more than 1-2 hours a week at your convenience



2. Wesquage Pond Water Sample Collection for URI Watershed Watch program - 4 Volunteers needed from May to October:

- Weekly collection of water samples (No prior experience is needed)
- A marker is placed in pond where sample is taken. Access point is the Camden Landing (a dinghy, kayak or canoe is needed)
- Training will be provided by the URI Watershed Program in March/April 2025
- Time commitment is 1-2 hours a week during monitoring season on a day that is most convenient for you. (will rotate volunteers)
